O.P. Jindal Global University is a non-profit university established by the Haryana Private Universities (Second Amendment) Act, 2009 at Sonipat, Haryana (NCR of Delhi). The University Grants Commission (UGC) has notified JGU as a private university established by the state legislature of Haryana.

Jindal Global Business School (JGBS), India's first multi-disciplinary global business school, is situated on a state of the art 54-acre, fully residential JGU campus. JGBS will impart global education with a view to producing world-class professionals.

The vision of JGBS is to equip its students and empower its faculty with knowledge, skills and scholarship that are necessary to meet the challenges and demands of globalisation. Its research centres will pro-actively work on cutting edge global business issues ranging from social entrepreneurship to green technologies and wealth creation and family business.



## 2010–2012 MBA Programme

Starting August 2010, Jindal Global Business School will be offering an unique two year global Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme.

### Objective and Programme Details

The objective of the MBA programme is to train students to take up junior and middle level management roles.

- Students will gain management perspectives through an unique pedagogy of learning and interaction among peers.
- The programme will offer an opportunity to students to exchange their ideas with distinguished faculty and professionals.
- An important aspect of the programme will be focus on emerging needs of the industry.

- The programme will be rigorous and intense, encouraging learning beyond the classroom.
- Students will be taught to respond to business issues quickly and skillfully.

## Global Immersion Programme

## How to Apply

### Eligibility

Bachelors degree in any subject with not less than 50% aggregate marks (students graduating in 2010 can apply).

## Admissions Procedure

JGBS invites applications from those who have taken the Common Admission Test (CAT-2009 and revised CAT 2009-10) conducted by the Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) for admission to the two-year MBA programme for the academic year 2010-11.

JGBS also invites applications from those Non Resident Indian and international students who have taken the globally Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT - 2007 or later) for admission to the two-year MBA programme for the academic year 2010-11. This test is conducted by the Graduate Management Admissions Council (GMAC) through Pearson VUE.

**Proposed Intake: 120 students**

### Selection Process

Shortlist 1 will be based on a cut off from CAT/ GMAT scores.

Shortlist 2 will be generated on the basis of an assessment test to evaluate the following skills:

- Lateral thinking and clarity of thought
- Logical thinking and sequencing
- Initiative and group dynamics
- Environmental sensitivity and understanding of key issues of contemporary importance

The evaluation will be quantitative and objective with the involvement of reputed independent assessment centres.

The final shortlist will then be made on the basis of a personal interview and scores of CAT/GMAT and assessment tests.

## Scholarships and Fellowships

### O.P. Jindal Outstanding Merit Scholarships

The top three CAT test scorers and top two GMAT test scorers who enroll in the two year MBA programme will be offered the O.P. Jindal Outstanding Merit Scholarship of Rs. 1 lakh each. This will be based purely on their performance in the CAT and GMAT Scores.

### Naveen Jindal Young Global Scholarships

JGBS will select two Naveen Jindal Young Global Scholars each year from among the students enrolling at JGBS. The aim of the scholarships is to nurture, encourage and support young global leaders. Two students from the two year MBA programme will be awarded these scholarship on the basis of an independent selection process. An award of Rs. 5 lakhs will be given to each student.

### Shallu Jindal Outstanding Women Scholarships

JGBS will select two Shallu Jindal Outstanding Women Scholars each year from among the students enrolling at JGBS. The aim of the scholarships is to nurture, encourage and support outstanding women to enter the field of business. Four students from the two year MBA programme will be awarded these scholarship on the basis of an independent selection process. An award of Rs. 2 lakhs will be given to each student.

### Savitri Jindal Merit cum Means Fellowship

To facilitate the accessibility of meritorious students to study at JGBS, who may not otherwise be able to afford such education due to their economic standing and inadequate financial support, JGBS is offering an ambitious and generous "Savitri Jindal Merit cum Means Fellowship".

### Educational Loans

JGU has tied up with HDFC Bank to facilitate the provision of educational loans to students who are admitted to full-time courses at JGU.
